
## Dr. Hunt



## **Crafting a Email**

- Always use a greeting
- Proofread your email
- Know who you are emailing, do research
- Clearly explain who you are and why you're emailing
- Sign off with a professional ending
  - Ie thank you, best
  - Know who you're emailing
