- e. one (1) topical/analytical course from the list below
- f. one (1) anthropological methods course from the list below
- g. four (4) additional ANP courses, at least three (3) of which must be at the 300 or 400 level
- h. ANP 489 – Anthropology Capstone Course

2. A **minimum overall 2.0 GPA** in Anthropology course work.
